

ABOUT MEET YOUR MAKER

A split second before the biggest show of her career, an Indigenous pop star goes missing. Wrestling with every choice she's ever made; our icon traverses deep time to meet her makers in an attempt to discover the truth.

Set in the fictional universe of Queen's City this story re-imagines a world where Indigenous people were given their land back. In another time, we get to see what might happen if we had gone down a different path, if Indigenous pop culture was the norm and not the token.





THE PERFORMANCE

Produced by Blak Social, the story is told through live performance by Alethea Beetson, and filmed content performed by up to 20 Indigenous actors + musicians (and some allies). The world is told through the reclamation of pop culture:

- Entertainment Tonight becomes Doris Tonight
- ONE DIRECTION become STAUNCH DIRECTION
- The Muppets become The Cuzzies
- Blak musicians like Stella Sovereign, Lou Solid & The Ancient Rocks, and Deadly Riot rule the airwaves



ABOUT ALETHEA BEETSON

Dr Alethea Beetson is a Kabi Kabi/Gubbi Gubbi + Wiradjuri storyteller and dreamer. In 2013 Alethea founded Digi Youth Arts (DYA) is an Indigenous led youth arts organisation sharing the stories of our young people; and in 2019 she founded Blak Social an Indigenous arts company working across music, film and theatre. Alethea holds a Doctorate of Creative Industries specialising in the creative development of Indigenous performance. She is currently the Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Program Lead at Spotify.

Her tenure at Digi Youth Arts has seen Alethea write and direct the following productions from a community engaged practice: COOKED (2022, QPAC), ANTHRO-APOLOGY (2018, Queensland Museum), Waiting and Searching (2016, Metro Arts), Don't Read The Comments (2016, Metro Arts), in-dij-uh-nus (2015, Brisbane Powerhouse; 2016 Festival of Pacific Arts in Guam; 2018, La Boite Theatre Company), Losing It (2017, La Boite Theatre Company); and direct Restless Dream (2021, Brisbane Festival), The Truth Is (2014, Twelfth Night Theatre) & Glad Tomorrow (2013, Brisbane Powerhouse).

In 2022 Alethea debuted Queen's City (writer/director) as part of Brisbane Festival and also Blak Social independently produced by Blak Social. Alethea also adapted and directed Alexis Wright's Carpentaria as an immersive literary performance for Brisbane Writers Festival in 2017 and 2019.

In 2021 Alethea adapted one of her theatre works Losing It into a short-film and directed this work in line with her existing Indigenous storytelling practices. Her move to film storytelling continues in 2023 with the impending debut of Blak Social + Selves' visual album Red Desert Dream - the product of pilot program Blak Narrative Music Videos - Volume One.

Blak Social is an Indigenous arts company dreamed into existence by Alethea Beetson (Kabi Kabi/Gubbi Gubbi and Wiradjuri). We currently work across music, performance and film.

Alethea Beetson established Blak Social after successfully founding a renowned Indigenous youth arts organisation, Digi Youth Arts, to continue creating spaces for the sovereign-led development and presentation of Indigenous stories and connected arts practice.
